The Forest Centre

The Thames Chase Forest Centre is based in historic farm buildings amidst 140 acres of community forest; land comprising new woods, meadows, ponds and surfaced paths. The Education Service gives young people the chance to come and learn new skills and try different outdoor activities in an exciting and safe environment.

Wildlife Model Making

Make models of your favourite animals or create your own mythical creature using recycled materials or different types of clay.

Minibeast Hunt

Explore the Thames Chase Forest and discover the amazing world of insects!

Teddy Bears Picnic

When you come down to the woods today, be sure of a big surprise. Meet the Thames Chase bear and join him on a Teddy Bears Picnic. Your teddy is invited.

Woodland Colours

Come to Thames Chase and discover shapes and colours of the woodland. Create your own woodland art using colours and shapes.

Natural Art & Craft

Take a walk through the woods collecting materials for an art and craft session with a woody theme.

6. First Alphabet with Thames Chase

Discover the alphabet using woodland examples. Create your own woodland dictionary.

7. Animal Puppets

Create your own animal puppet from recycled material collected by Thames Chase. Use drama to bring life to the puppet.

8. Animal Antics

Make animal masks and pretend to be the animal you have created.

9. Woodland Numbers

Use the woodland to learn to count. Follow the trail through the woods counting the acorns as you go.

If you have a particular topic that you have been covering within your group and wish to pursue that here at the centre, please call the Project Assistant who will help to devise a programme to suit your ideas.

Some of the activities like the Teddy Bears picnic are best done in warmer months such as spring/summer

Sessions are charged at £25 per hour (for one member of staff, who can take up to 20 children).

Weekdays are preferable, but weekend sessions are possible subject to an additional charge.
